Kim John Payne is a therapist and school counselor who speaks about how teachers and parents can effectively work with the social struggles children encounter at school and at home. Recommending a "no blame" approach for children who appear to display antisocial behaviors, Kim sets out a careful plan that cultivates impulse control, politeness and courtesy in both the classroom and the home.

Through building empathy and perspective, children learn how to change patterns of behavior. By instructing teachers and parents in how to coach children, a climate of respect and cooperation can be achieved.

Kim Payne has worked in schools around the world, helping them create positive community cultures.
